16S and shotgun metagenomic sequencing for microbial community profiling.

Two depths of answer on the same question. 16S tells you who is present; shotgun tells you what they can do, and down to the strain. Host and microbiome can be read from the same collection.

16S rRNA sequencing	Taxonomic composition of a bacterial community	Comparing communities between conditions, sites or timepoints
Shotgun metagenomics	The whole community, genes included	Functional potential and strain-level resolution
Host-microbiome studies	Host transcriptome and microbiome from one collection	Infection, inflammation and barrier studies
Extraction from difficult matrices	Nucleic acid recovered from stool, swabs and biofilms	Sample types where standard extraction underperforms

WHAT THESE TECHNOLOGIES LET YOU DO

Find out who is there

Taxonomic profiling across a cohort, with the same protocol on every sample.

Read host and microbe together

One collection, two layers, no second sampling visit.

Shotgun sequencing resolves genes and strains, not only genera.

Compare communities fairly

Batch-controlled processing, so a difference between groups is not a difference between runs.
